#### Transportation

- A wheelchair-inclusive shuttle is available and will give you and your party a ride. Call 863-275-2211 for assistance.
- If you need a shuttle ride to your car, please allow us to help.

#### Food

- Food and beverage dining locations are accessible to both caregivers and persons in wheelchairs.
- A wheelchair-accessible picnic table is located across from Indiana Avenue.
